The Museum is receiving a Capital Appropriation from the State of Ohio for \$275,000 toward the project.

You can help the museum qualify for the funds by contributing to the local match of \$185,000.

The funds are only available for a 2 year period. It is imperative to raise the funds so the project can be completed according to the Ohio Facilities Construction Commission guidelines.

The museum will be transformed into an educational experience for area youth and adults.
